



Policy: Parental Supervision in the Kite Centre Car Park and Surrounding Areas

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to ensure the safety and well-being of children in the Kite Centre's car park and surrounding waterways by requiring parental supervision at all times.

Policy Statement:

1. Parents/guardians are responsible for supervising their children in the Kite Centre's car park and surrounding areas, including any nearby waterways.
2. Children should not be left unattended in the car park or near creek beds, waterways or the Kite Centre pool at any time. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure their child's safety.
3. Parents/guardians must hold their children's hands or closely supervise them while walking through the car park to prevent accidents or injuries.
4. Children should not be allowed to play or wander unsupervised in the car park or near waterways that may pose a drowning hazard.
5. If a child requires assistance, the parent/guardian must provide it or make appropriate arrangements to ensure the child's safety.
6. Any concerns about child safety in the car park or surrounding waterways should be reported to Kite Centre staff immediately for assistance.

Implementation:

1. This policy will be communicated to all parents/guardians upon their arrival at the medical centre.
2. Signs will be posted in the car park and around the waterways reminding parents of their responsibility to supervise their children.
3. Medical centre staff will also remind parents of this policy if they observe unsupervised children in these areas.

Compliance:

1. Failure to comply with this policy may result in the parent/guardian being asked to provide appropriate supervision or leave the premises with their child.
2. Any incidents or concerns regarding child safety in the car park or surrounding waterways should be reported to Kite Centre management for investigation and resolution.
